CONCOR CSR activities continued to be focused on its stakeholders living around its facilities as per provisions of Companies Act 2013. For smooth implementation of its CSR project, CONCOR has constituted a CSR committee headed by Chairman and managing director as its Chairman and three directors including two independent directors as member of CSR committee.

The CSR Committee is supported by Tier two CSR committee comprising of senior officers who evaluate CSR proposals and recommend to CSR committee for its approval.
