### **E-EOI FOR EMPANELMENT OF TRANSPORTERS AT REGIONAL LEVEL FOR NORTHERN REGION TERMINALS.**

In reference to pre-bid meeting held on 20.01.2020, the issues raised by the bidders regarding the tender clauses and clarifications to the respective clauses are as under:

1.	Regarding GST - Kindly note that as per the forward charge mechanism of GST, we shall charge 12% GST exclusive of rate quoted by us on the mobile app. 100% Input tax credit for the same may be claimed by your organisation. Kindly approve.	Applicable rules of GST will be followed.
2.	Regarding Reserve Price - Kindly clarify that if a bidder quotes 1% as reserve price will it be considered over and above the 1% stated in the schedule of rates or will it be considered as 1% only. Also, can a bidder quote in decimal points? Kindly clarify.	<p>As per Ch.II, Cl 7.2 : “The empanelled contractor/transporter will pay CONCOR minimum 1% (Reserve Price) of the bill amount (excluding Taxes) as service charge for the movement carried out by the transporters”.</p> <p>As per Ch.II, Cl 7.3: “Bidder has to quote the percentage of service charges he is offering over &amp; above reserve price as stated in the Para 7.2 above to CONCOR as per Annexure-I.”</p> <p>Yes, Bidder can quote in decimal points.</p>
3.	Regarding PF and ESI - If a bidder is not registered under PF and ESI, can such bidder participate in the EOI on the basis of an undertaking stating that they shall apply for PF and ESI registration and shall get the registrations done before the start of work?	Bidders not having PF/ESI registration may submit an undertaking that they will obtain the PF/ESI registration before commencement of contract.
4.	Regarding Past Experience - If a bidder has an ongoing transportation contract, can such bidder upload the copy of	Bidders may refer Para 1.1 of Chapter-II regarding Experience Certificate.

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	agreement and copy of relevant 26 AS and also a notarised undertaking on bidder's letter head stating the monetary value of work completed and the Metric Tonnes (MT) of work completed till date, shall such combined trio of documents (undertaking, agreement and 26 AS) be enough to fulfil the criteria of experience, provided that the Metric Tonnes (MT) of work completed till date is greater than 13000 MT.	
5.	How does CONCOR intend to make this initiative successful?	CONCOR plans to introduce the services of first mile last mile connectivity of containers through mobile app initially at Five (05) terminals of Northern Region as per Annexure VIII, and gradually this facility will be expanded/activated to all terminals of Northern Region. Transporters empanelled with CONCOR on regional level (NR) will have the privilege to work at any of the activated terminals for FMLM connectivity.
6.	Will there be live bidding for every Job Order issued?	Bidders may refer Para 2 of Chapter-III regarding Procedure of Execution of Job Order.
7.	Normally EMD stipulated in CONCOR Tenders is Rs.5 Lakhs or below, but as in this case EMD is Rs.10 Lakhs, kindly permit EMD in the form of Bank Guarantee in lieu of EMD.	Bidders may refer Para 2 of Chapter-II regarding EMD payment conditions.
