Financial Eligibility Criteria	The sum total (arithmetic Sum) of tenderer's turnover/revenue (income) from operations for three financial years (i.e.2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19) should be of value not lesser than 90% (i.e. Rs.78.20 Lakhs) of the advertised tender value of the work i.e. estimated cost of the work. The information shall be supported by CA certificate & Balance Sheets and Profit & Loss statements of specified three financial years.
Experience with respect to similar nature of work	Tenderer should have experience of having successfully completed at least one similar work(i.e.Electrical installation or Electrical repair or Maintenance of electrical installation) of value 35% (i.e.Rs.30.41 Lakhs) of the advertised tender value of the work i.e. estimated cost of the work, during four financial years (i.e.2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19) & upto the date of tender submission.

- 6. EMD & Tender Cost should be paid in favour of **Container Corporation of India Limited** through e-payment and the receipt of the same should be scanned and uploaded in the e-tendering website www.tenderwizard.com/CCIL, along with E-Tender document.
- 7. To participate in the E-Tender, it is mandatory for the bidder to have user ID & password, which has to be obtained by submitting an annual registration charges of Rs.1500/-+GST @18.00% to ITI, through e-payment.
- 8. The E-payment of Tender Document Cost, Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) and Tender Processing Fee shall be paid through payment Gateway of CONCOR in E-Tendering Portal at www.tenderwizard.com/CCIL).
- Corrigendum/Addendum to this Tender, if any, will be published on website www.tenderwizard.com/CCIL only. Newspaper press advertisement shall not be issued for the same.
- 10. Joint Venture firms can apply, in case of estimated advertised tender value above Rs.10 Crores.
- 11. CONCOR Terminals/ Project Sites are not covered under the definition of "Port", Governmental Organization or Railway, as per the definition contained in Goods and Service Tax Department notifications. As such, GST shall be applicable on CONCOR works and shall not be reimbursed by CONCOR. The details regarding applicability of GST is available at clause 13.2 of "Instructions to Tenderers". Therefore, tenderer / bidder shall quote their rates inclusive of GST, as applicable after study the same and GST will not be paid/ reimbursed by CONCOR.

- 12. GST, Building & other construction workers cess or any other tax, levies, duties on materials and on complete works in respect of this contract shall be payable by the Contractor and CONCOR will not entertain any claim what so ever in this respect. This should be included in the rates quoted by Contractor.
- 13. The Contractor shall be required to pay cess@1% of cost of construction work in accordance with each bill payable on account of such construction to the concerned State of Govt. (Labour Deptt.). Cost of material shall be outside the purview of cess, when supplied under a separate schedule items. CONCOR shall not entertain any claim whatsoever in this respect.
- 14. Insurances (i.e. Contractor All risk policy & Workmen Compensation Policy) for works, persons and property shall be taken by the contractor at his own cost for the entire duration of the project. Therefore, tenderer shall quote their rates inclusive of premium amounts of the Insurance Policies.
- 15. If the overall rate, quoted by two or more qualified successful bidders, is the lowest and same, then the successful bidder will be selected on the basis of lottery in presence of concerned bidders. The Tender Evaluation Committee will conduct the lottery.
- 16. No Escalation on account of any increase in price index in the price of materials, imposition of Good and Service Tax or other tax etc. or imposition of levies etc. Price Variation clause (PVC) is not applicable in this work contract.

#### 19. (A) Public Procurement Policy - MSE

- a) Tender document should be provided free of cost to MSEs registered with the nominated agencies.
- b) MSEs will be exempted from payment of earnest money.
- c) In case of e-Tendering, registration amount and tender processing fee will be applicable as per the requirement of e-tender.
- d) In case MSEs do not provide the below mentioned document, it should be made clear that such offer will not be entertained.
- e) The tender item is Non-Split-able, hence participating MSEs quoting a price within price band of L1 + 15% shall not be applicable in this case.
- f) In order to avail benefirts/preferential treatment, the MSEs must be registered with any of the following:
  - (i) District Industries Centers
  - (ii) Khadi and Village Industries Commission
  - (iii) Khadi and Village Industries Board

- (iv) Coir Board
- (v) National Small Industries Corporation

- (viii) MSEs have started Udyog Aadhar Memorandum, an online registration system since 18<sup>th</sup> September,2015 and all the MSEs who are having Udyog Aadhar Memorandum will be given all benefits available under Public Procurement Policy for MSEs order, 2012.

## 19. (B) Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) order 2017:

In procurements of goods/services/works which are not divisible, and in procurement of services where the bid is evaluated on price alone, the following procedure shall be followed:-

- a) Among all qualified bids, the lowest bid will be termed as L1. If L1 is from a local supplier, the contract will be awarded to L1.
- b) If L1 is not from a local supplier, the lowest bidder among the local suppliers, will be invited to match the L1 price subject to local supplier's quoted price falling within the margin of purchase preference(L1+20%), and the contract shall be awarded to such local supplier subject to matching the L1 price.
- c) In case such lowest eligible local supplier fails to match the L1 price, the local supplier with the next higher bid within the margin of purchase preference (L1+20%) shall be invited to match the L1 price and so on and contract shall be awarded accordingly. In case none of the local suppliers within the margin of purchase preference matches the L1 price, then the contract may be awarded to the L1 bidder.

The local supplier shall be required to provide a certificate (self-certification as per the enclosure-II supported by CA if the estimate cost of tender is <Rs.10 Crore and if the estimate cost of Tender is <Rs.10 Crore Certificate from the statutory auditor or cost auditor of the company) stating that "the item offered meets the minimum local content and shall give details of the location(s) at which the local value addition is made".

### 19. (C) Policy on Startup:

In the subject tender no relaxation to be given to Startup(other than H&T, Survey tenders) on account of Prior turnover/Prior experience(certified by DIPP as per gazette notification dated 11/04/2018). Hence, Prior turnover/Prior experience(certified by DIPP as per gazette notification dated 11/04/2018) will be as it is and applicable accordingly.
