The bidder should have / should provide support office in Delhi / NCR and in and around Mihan, Nagpur to provide necessary support.

## \*Constitution of Consortium:

One of the members of the Consortium shall be the lead member who shall have an at least 60% share of interest in it. Other members of Consortium shall have at least 15% (fifteen per cent) stake each.
